Dress

Perhaps the single most important thing to ensure your child's enjoyment of the explorer walk is to dress them warmly and in layers. It may be cold and it could be windy and wet. Make sure your child brings along a good quality water proof coat with a hood and, if possible, waterproof trousers. A sturdy pair of boots or shoes or welly boots is essential. If it is sunny please send your child with a sunhat. Part of the adventure is the great opportunity for experiencing the natural world in all sorts of weather conditions, but we want your child to enjoy the experience, so please dress them accordingly. Swainswick Explorers also have a number of coats, trousers, boots etc which they can lend out on the day.

Please bring

- your own small rucksack with enough drinking water for yourself
- we provide all your food for the day
- a note for older children - please don't bring your penknife, we supply our own tools and supervise their use

Getting to Swainswick Explorers

By car from Bath

Come up the Gloucester Road (where Alice Park is), past the empty garage forecourt and turn left immediately into Upper Swainswick village. (You can also turn off left from the new A46 dual carriageway and turn immediately right into the village).

From M4

Junction 18, take the A46 down towards Bath. Come off at Swainswick turning, under bridge, turn right for Swainswick, go past car sales garage (now see below).

Parking

Please park in as soon as you turn into the village. You can park in the bus turning on your left or under the Cedar of Lebanon tree which is also on your left as you come into the village. It is only a minute's walk from our house. Please do not park in the lane approaching our house as it makes the lane too narrow for wider vehicles to pass. **The garage next to our house is not ours so please do not block its access.**

Upper Swainswick House is where we live and the house is on the left, opposite the village green. The green side door is the way in.
