### Explorer Event

#### What to wear

- at least 3 layer of clothes, and clothes you don't mind getting grubby
- a waterproof jacket, thicker the better
- long sleeved t-shirts and long trousers protect against ticks, nettles, brambles
- **hat and gloves (waterproof better than wool which quickly gets wet) are very sensible and make all the difference on a very cold day**
- old trainers or wellies with a good grip

- your own small rucksack with enough drinking water for yourself
- we provide all your food for the day
- don't bring your penknife, we supply our own tools and supervise their use

#### Getting to Swainswick Explorers

##### By car from Bath

Come up the Gloucester Road (where Alice Park is), past the empty garage forecourt and turn left immediately into Upper Swainswick village. (You can also turn off left from the new A46 dual carriageway and turn immediately right into the village).

##### From M4

Junction 18, take the A46 down towards Bath. Come off at Swainswick turning, under bridge, turn right for Swainswick, go past car sales garage (now see below).

##### Parking

Please park in as soon as you turn into the village. You can park in the bus turning on your left or under the Cedar of Lebanon tree which is also on your left as you come into the village. It is only a minute's walk from our house. Please do not park in the lane approaching our house as it makes the lane too narrow for wider vehicles to pass. **The garage next to our house is not ours so please do not block its access.**

Upper Swainswick House is where we live and the house is on the left, opposite the village green. The green side door is the way in.
